MORNING ENTRY TO SCHOOL

- The inside front door will remain closed and locked at all times.
- Children arriving to school between 8.15am-9am will enter via the P.1 door and go to the hall for breakfast club/ supervision.
- All children coming to school between 9am and 9.15 am will enter via their class cloakroom door. These doors will only be opened at 9am.
- **Parent access into the school has been restricted to P.1 parents only.** P.1 parents are allowed access into the cloakroom area in the morning with their child until Christmas.
- The School day begins at 9.15am and the children **must** be in their classrooms by this time for morning register. Children arriving after 9.15am must enter school via the office and a late mark will be given.

HOME TIME COLLECTION

- After School Club children will be collected by Miss Heatley from the classrooms at 2:10pm and remain with her.
- Children for collection by parents/carers will leave school through the appropriate cloakroom door and walk via the playground to the front of the building with a teacher.
- Children travelling by bus will leave school through the appropriate cloakroom door and walk via the playground to the buses with a classroom assistant.
- If not collected, a child will remain in school until contact is made with the parent/named carer.
- A change of routine will only happen if we receive a written parental request (excluding emergencies).
- For the P3 parents we would like to remind you that the collection time for your child is as follows; Monday-Wednesday 3.10pm, Thursday & Friday 2.10pm.

MEDICINES

If your child needs to take **prescribed medication** during school hours, please come to the school office and sign a consent form.

ATTENDANCE

All children should attend school for 190 days that the law requires, unless they are ill. If children have to miss for illness or any other reason, or are going to be late arriving at school then parents should contact the school before 9.30am. We would prefer non urgent doctor/dentist/optician appointments to be made after school hours where possible. We expect family holidays to be taken during the school closures. **It is essential that the school receives a note from parents giving a reason for any absence. Notes will be required for any morning or afternoon appointments.** Parents of children who are missing school regularly may need to receive support from the EA Western Region Educational Welfare Officer to improve this situation. Please find attached a sheet of notes which can be used for your child in the event of absence/ appointment.
