We are excited to announce that school has been successful in a bid for Shared Education, available through PEACE 4 funding. We will be working on educational projects with St Mary's Cloghor and Artigarvan PS over the next couple of years. Our first project is planned to improve problem solving skills within Key Stage 2, with our P5-P7 pupils engaging in activities with other pupils during the Spring and Summer term this academic year.
